We are pleased to share details of the **National Support Offer – QI Course for Physiological Sciences Cohort 3**, developed by NHS Elect with input from NHS England and regional colleagues.

The programme is designed to foster collaboration, share best practices, and support professional development across all physiological science disciplines.

## Course Focus

A Quality Improvement course where participants explore the key stages of delivering a successful QI project across four sessions. Using a shared example during sessions, they will identify their own real-time improvement project and apply learning in their own services, reinforcing understanding through practice.

## Who Should Join?

The programme is designed for **professionals currently in leadership roles or those aspiring to step into such roles in the future.**

This cohort will include 65 participants, This is to ensure an optimal learning environment and effective engagement.

## Delivery Format

This course will be delivered virtually via Microsoft Teams and requires a total of 4 full-days commitment over a six-month period (6 weekly). Additional wraparound support will also be provided.

## Learning Approach

- Project-based learning, with participants applying insights to real-time improvement work.
- Access to an online resource pack (Mural and other platforms) will be provided.
