

December 2025 Regulation Board Meeting Summary

The Regulation Board met online. The CEO updated the board on various ongoing projects including Advancing Clinical Practise with NHS England, Wellbeing Workshops, a review by HCPC on Equivalence, the upcoming annual review by the PSA and the Honorary Fellows event in March 2026. Healthcare Science Leads from each country have been appointed through the Professional Bodies Council. An update was given on the progress of recruiting for a new AHCS Chair, with the recruitment due to close, and the AHCS response to the Kingdon report.

The Registrar's report was discussed. There are 9 current Fitness to Practise cases, 1 case closed since August 2025 and 1 new case since August 2025. An update was given on the progress for recruiting new Chairs for FTP Panels.

Reports were received from the Education and Training Committee, including the appointment of a new external examiner.

The Chair led a discussion around the publication of fitness to practice decisions and the amount of detail provided on the website, noting that it varied across regulators. It was agreed that this would be an agenda item for 2026 and to gain feedback from registrants.

The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the Regulation Board were reviewed and agreed no changes were needed. The Board reflected on its key indicators of success, aligned to the TOR, highlighting achievements and items to be included in the agenda for 2026.
